AWAB ADIL AL-SHWAIKH

MR. AWAB ADIL AL-SHWAIKH is currently Assistant Secretary General and Director of Projects for the Sharjah Petroleum Council, and serves as a member of the Council's contracts committee. He has also held the temporary position of assistant to the financial and legal advisor of Sharjah National Oil Corporation.

Mr. Al-Shwaikh has extensive experience in the energy sector. negotiation of assets, and technical and financial studies and consultancy. Hence, he has developed both technical and financial expertise in the energy sector.

Mr. Al-Shwaikh is a distinguished graduate of the Department of Mechanical Engineering at the United Arab Emirates University, from which he also holds a Professional Diploma in Accounting and Finance from the Department of Accounting, College of Business and Economics.
